We need your help!

There have been several near mishaps in our parking lot in recent weeks. **Too many people are driving entirely too fast!** Please be aware that children are entering and exiting our building. Make sure to park and bring younger dancers inside. To keep traffic from backing up, please do not stop in the middle of the parking lot. Also, the owner of the Richland Tower Bank & Office Building has complained on several occasions that people are cutting across the parking lot rather than the designated entrance & exits driving entirely too fast and distracted by phones. We are now on a complete online accounting system and late fees are automatically added after the 10<sup>th</sup> of each month. Any dancer with an account over 60 days past due will not be allowed to participate in class until their account is made current.
